

SERMON TOPIC: The Joy of Letting Go

SERMON SUMMARY

The sermon focused on the theme 'Hope for the Holidays,' exploring the life and character of Mary, the mother of Jesus. The message emphasized the joy and peace that come from letting go of our own plans and embracing God's plan for our lives. Through the story of Mary, who was an ordinary young girl used by God in an extraordinary way, the sermon highlighted the importance of seeking God's favor over personal fame, His presence over our own plans, and His glory over our personal goals. The sermon encouraged the congregation to submit to God's will, just as Mary did, and to find true satisfaction in His presence.

- 5. Jesus is the ultimate gift, bringing hope and salvation to all.

- 8. How does the story of Mary challenge you to trust in God's plan for your life?
