

SERMON TOPIC: Messages From Heaven

SERMON SUMMARY

This week's sermon focused on the messages from Revelation 14, emphasizing the eternal destinies of those who accept or reject Christ. It highlighted the triumph of the Lamb of God, the importance of worship, the certainty of judgment for those who reject God, and the call to live a life that bears fruit in accordance with God's will. The pastor urged the congregation to reflect on their spiritual state and to ensure they are connected to the true vine, Jesus Christ, producing fruits of the Spirit.

- 1. The Lamb of God is victorious and stands triumphant.
- 2. Worship should be directed solely towards God, who is the creator of all. Judgment is certain for those who reject God, but His grace is available to all.
- 4. Our lives should produce fruits that reflect our connection to Jesus.
- 5. The gospel is everlasting and meant for all people, everywhere.
