SERMON TOPIC: Brand New Life

SERMON SUMMARY

This week's sermon focuses on how Jesus Christ transforms believers by giving them a new perspective, making them new people, and providing them with a new purpose. Pastor Clark emphasizes that God sees people differently than humans do, and through Christ, anyone can become a new creation. The message centers on 2 Corinthians 5, highlighting God's work of reconciliation through Christ and our role as His ambassadors.
